

CDHS Alumni Association School Spirit Scholarship

Application Procedures

Two \$1,000 Scholarships shall be awarded to two students who:

1. are a member of the CDHS Class of 2012.
2. have received a written acceptance from a post-secondary institution and have agreed, in writing, to attend the institution within six months of graduation.

The scholarship(s) shall be awarded based on the contents of the attached School Spirit Application, which is **due in the high school Guidance Office by Tuesday April 10, 2012**. Financial need will not be a consideration. Eligibility or preference of selection shall in no way be affected by race, religion, or gender. Application packets will be judged on completeness; make sure you have all required signatures, references, documentation, and the essay. The four areas of School Spirit include the following:

#1. PERSONAL SPIRIT

Defined as scholastic achievement, good citizenship, acceptance at a post-secondary institution, and any additional enrichment courses or activities.

Documentation:

1. Copy of the letter of acceptance from a post-secondary institution. *
2. Copy of your letter of acceptance to attend the institution. *
3. Completed reference form from a school employee. (Use enclosed Reference Form)

**If these items are not available at the time of application, a list of institutions where you have applied should be provided.*

#2. SCHOOL SPIRIT

Defined as participation in scholastic and extracurricular activities.

Documentation:

Listing of all scholastic and extracurricular activities from 9th grade to present (the Guidance Office can provide this information to you). Include offices, positions held in the clubs or activities, and what years you served. [See Application Form provided]

#3. COMMUNITY SPIRIT

Defined as participation in religious institutions, volunteer activities, and community activities. Work experience should also be listed.

Documentation:

Listing of all activities outside of school from 9th grade to present. [See Application Form provided]

#4. SCHOOL SPIRIT ESSAY

This application must include your written response to the essay question below. The essay should be no longer than 2 – 3 double-spaced, typewritten pages; this will be judged on content, grammar, and spelling. The topic question is:

“What is the Value of School Spirit Today and in the Future?” (Ideas below)

- **In what ways do/did you demonstrate school spirit?**
- **How do you think school spirit affects you, your classmates, and the community, both short and long term?**
- **How will you continue to promote CDHS school spirit in the future?**
- **How can school spirit be improved at Central Dauphin High School?**
